

Students are to be nominated for this program by a school representative. The criteria for participant selection are strong science and mathematical ability, and an interest in a career in STEM. We are especially interested in students from groups that are under-represented in STEM professions. Two entering sophomores and two entering juniors from each high school may be recommended. Applications must be signed by a school representative.

There is no tuition for this program. A \$60 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve the student's place. University of Buffalo scholarship funds are awarded to all students who participate in this program and who subsequently attend UB's School of Engineering and Applied Sciences.
