Rick Volker, Aerobatic Champion



Please join us this month when champion aerobatic pilot Rick Volker tells us what it's like to fly the Sukhoi 26M, probably the highest performance aerobatic aircraft in the world. With a 400 horsepower radial engine and weighing less than a thousand pounds, the SU-26M has a thrust to weight ratio greater than 1:1 and is stressed for ± 12 Gs. In addition to the Sukhoi, Rick has also flown exhibitions in the Spitfire Mk. IX, Me-109, Hawker Hurricane, and Harvard (T-6 and SNJ to us). When not performing, he is a piston warbird, high performance, and formation aerobatic ACE (Aerobatic Competency Evaluator), and has trained numerous aerobatic pilots in the Sukhoi SU-29, Extra 300L and Pitts Specials.
