On **Tuesday, September 4th**, there will be a series of **Pathways internship positions** posted at **Johnson Space Center** in Houston, TX. Links to the positions which will open on 9/4 are at the bottom of this email. Pathways positions at NASA are internships geared towards current students that may be eligible for conversion into a civil servant position with the agency. Pathways positions are posted in the [USAJOBS](#) system. Applying for a position via USAJOBS can be very different than some other application systems, so if you plan to apply, it is a good idea to look through [these guidelines](#) regarding how to build a resume in the system and create your profile/general application in advance. **Be sure to thoroughly read the position descriptions and tailor your application for each position for which you apply.** If there are options to include references be sure to list them.

It is also good to be aware that due to the large number of applications usually received for Pathways positions, **many positions may close early if a certain number of applications are submitted.** This means it is important to create your profile in the system in advance, and quickly apply to positions that interest you as they are posted.

Please note that the Pathways program is separate from the NASA Internships program, so any questions about the process or positions should be directed to the contacts listed in the postings. **The NASA Internships program does not accept applications or resumes for the Pathways program.**
