# Summer 2018 Engineering Study Abroad Program in Troyes, France



**Experience the incredible culture, adventure, history, and excitement of Europe while earning UB credits studying at the University of Technology of Troyes in France.** Troyes, the historic capital of France's Champagne district, is a small city of 120,000 located about an hour and a half from Paris by road or rail.

While at the University of Technology of Troyes (UTT), you will take EAS 207 Statics from a UB faculty member, and Europe and France: Institutions, History and Civilization from a UTT faculty member. This course has been approved to meet the Civilization and History (C) or Humanities (H) UB Areas.

The program lasts approximately five weeks, from May 18 to June 24, 2018. In addition to classes, various excursions and cultural activities are organized, including a trip to Paris.

### Why take EAS 207 over the summer?

- Small class size
- Daily class meetings, with review of previous material and practice problems by the actual professor
- No other simultaneous technical courses, so you can focus on really learning and excelling in one course
- Professor that lives nearby, shares many meals and recreational activities with you outside of class, gets to know you personally, and is available for virtually unlimited office hours
