Completing a PhD is an exciting but challenging undertaking. The ISE PhD program, regardless of specialization, is structured to help students make progress towards their ultimate goal – a successful dissertation defense and graduation.

There are several important milestones to be aware of throughout a typical 5 year PhD program. Students, with assistance from their advisors and committee, are responsible for planning their work so that they are accomplishing milestones at appropriate times.

Students who have not met milestones by the appropriate dates will be notified by the graduate director that they are not making timely progress towards their degrees, and encouraged to meet with their advisor and the graduate director to understand and try to resolve any challenges that are causing delays. In awarding funding, the ISE department first considers students who are making timely progress in their programs.
